I understand that the program dates are August 13th - December 17th, 2020 and I will be present in San Diego during these dates. I understand that the ALI cannot guarantee enrollment in specific university courses. Semester at SDSU students enroll in courses on a space-available basis after matriculated SDSU students have enrolled. I understand that Semester at SDSU students will use an automated class enrollment system and, if placed on a class waitlist, will not have priority when enrolling in classes. I understand that enrollment will be restricted in certain departments, such as Nursing and Speech Language & Hearing Sciences. If I am enrolled in a course from the automated class enrollment system, I may be dropped from the course by the professor or department if I do not satisfy the requirements of the course. I understand that if my inability to enroll in my preferred courses will have a negative effect on my ability to graduate from my home university, then I will need to reconsider attending this program. I may have to enroll in courses that are not my preference if space is not available in the classes I desire. I understand that I am responsible for communication with my home university in a timely fashion about course transfers. If I learn after the add/drop deadline that a course I am enrolled in will not transfer to my home university, I understand that I will not be permitted to drop it. I understand that I must bring my transcript (in English) with me and have it readily available for viewing by staff and professors. I must make sure I have satisfied all prerequisites for a course. Professors have the authority to enforce prerequisites and may drop me from any course if I do not have the prerequisites or equivalent preparation for the course. I must be enrolled as a full-time student to maintain my F-1 visa status. Full-time status is 12 units for undergraduate students and 9 units for graduate students. I understand that I am required to attend all of my classes for the entire length of each class; therefore, I am not permitted to enroll in any classes that would require me to be in two places at the same time. I agree to enroll in courses that do not overlap in day or time, not even by one minute.

I understand that I can be dismissed at any time during the term if I have an attendance problem,

behavior problem, do not work up to the high standards of the ALI, or do not pay tuition and fees.
