Tuition

The above amounts are an estimate. Actual expenses may be higher. Tuition is calculated based on full-time enrollment (12 credits) in the fall and spring semesters. There will be an additional cost of \$421.88 per credit hour if you enroll in additional courses. New students must pay tuition at orientation, and returning students must pay tuition during registration. F1 students do not qualify for in-state tuition or federal financial aid.
