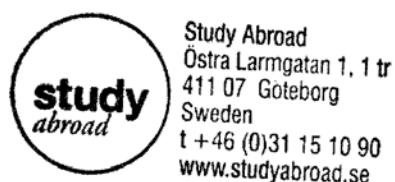

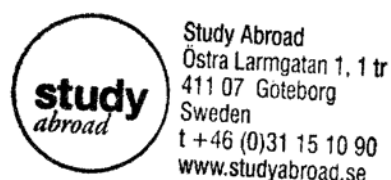

2) The access to the three year courses is subject to the successful completion of the entry test. Please refer to the page 7.

3) Participants who successfully complete the three year course Fashion Design 'RNCP' course taught in Paris receive the title of "Fashion Designer (Styliste-Créateur/trice)", acknowledged by the CNCP Commission Nationale de la Certification Professionnelle (National Commission for Vocational Certification) and registered as a Professional Certificate published in the JORF (Official Journal of the French Republic). As recognised vocational training, level II RNCP is equivalent to a three year program of higher education. For further details please do not hesitate to contact the information office at The Paris School.
